GENERAL SUMMARY: The Plant Manager is responsible for the management of all operations including safety, quality, productivity, employee relations, training, discipline issues, housekeeping, maintenance and budgets. Additionally on the customer side of the operation, the responsibilities include quality of the end products, corrective action process in the event of quality issues and the requirement to service the customer's product needs on a timely basis. The Plant Manager is responsible for all personnel, assets and the security of both on all shifts. It is the Plant Managers goal to manage the personnel and assets of the Component Division to achieve target profits.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Lead production teams in meeting their key performance indicators.
- Hire and develop and monitor the training of Standard Operating Processors. Develop cross training of co-workers to ensure a trained and flexible work force.
- Develop and maintain safe work practices, ensure production objectives are met within OSHA guidelines.
- Schedule the plant to achieve on time service to the customer.
- Manage Shop Floor Control processes, information and training. Ensure information is translated correctly in the BPIC's system and communicated to the Cost Estimator for costing model up-dates.
- Maintenance of co-worker staffing at optimum levels consistent with anticipated production levels.
- Address employee disciplinary issues in an appropriate and timely manner.
- Manage and monitor inventory levels throughout the operation consistent with required programmed customer service lead time requirements.
- Communicate a forward looking growth environment (vision) which will embrace change as an on-going opportunity for continuous improvement and business growth.
- Develop production systems and processes that can be transferred and implemented at additional facilities by using both internal and external support groups.
- Supervise equipment maintenance to ensure maximum up-time.
- Ensure a quality system is in place to meet customer specifications.
